With the award the society aims to promote a lasting interest in Eighteenth Century Studies.

#### **Award**

The winner will

- be invited to present his/her work in the award ceremony during the winter term 2009/10;
- be honoured with a prize money sponsored by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Science and Research;
- have the possibility to publish a summary of his/her research paper in the publications of the OGE 18.

#### **Application**

The work must be appraised between January 1st, 2007 and May 1st, 2009.

The applicant must turn in

- a hardback copy of his/her work
- a ten pages summary in English or German
- a CV

The managing board of the society will decide on the awardee and will consult with experts depending on the subject of the turned in thesis. The awardee will be notified by mail.

It does not exist any legal entitlement to the award. The applications must be sent no later than **May 31st, 2009** (date of postmark) and be addressed to:
